



ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

A) First Year Undergraduate:

The students who have passed Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination from Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or equivalent shall be eligible for admission to BBA-I, BCA-I & BCCA-I of the 4. The last date of admission to the college shall be according three years Degree course.

B) Second Year Undergraduate:

Students who have passed examinations of B.B.A. Part-I. B.C.A. Part-I and B.C.C.A. Part-I or equivalent shall be admitted to the second year of the respective classes. Students promoted under ATKT rules are also eligible.

C) Third Year Undergraduate:

Students who have passed examination of B.B.A. Part-II, B.C.A.Part-II and B.C.C.A.Part-II or equivalent shall be admitted to the respective third year classes. Students promoted under ATKT rules are also eligible.

Note: If a student cannot avail the facility of A.T.K.T. to get admission to the next year and yet inadvertently admitted to it, then his admission to this next year will not be valid. The fees paid will also not be refunded. The responsibility of any other consequences in such case shall lie upon the student.

RULES FOR ADMISSION:

The admission to the undergraduate classes shall be according to the rules and regulations of the Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj University and the State.

- 1. A) The original Transfer Certificate of the last educational institution attended is essential for admission. The Certificate will not be returned once admitted to the college. There will be no admission on the basis of the Duplicate Transfer Certificate.
- B) The original mark list of the last examination along with its attested copy is essential for admission.
- C) The fees once paid will not be refunded to the student who cancels his admission or leaves the college for another one after his/her admission.
- D) Only those students will be given admission in B.Com. Part-I English medium who have secured 50% or more in English language at H.S.S.C. or whose medium of instruction upto H.S.S.C. is English.
- E) More registration of Application form does not guarantee admission to the college.
- F) The faculty or medium once admitted to cannot be changed.
- G) Students from states other than Maharashtra shall have to furnish eligibility certificate of Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University at the time of admission to the college. He/she also has to submit Migration Certificate on or before 30th September, 2024.
- H) The applicant shall paste one passport size photograph on the **Application Form** and shall submit one for **I-Card**.
- As per UGC norms, the sports persons shall be given preference in admission.
- 3. The student has to pay the amount due to him at the time

- of admission. His / her admission can be cancelled if he/ she does not attend the college on the opening day or delays payment due to him on the same day without seeking the Principal's permission.
- to the date fixed by Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University.
- 5. The admission of the provisionally admitted student will be cancelled if he / she does not submit the necessary documents within the stipulated period. This will be according to the rules of the University and the college does not bear any responsibility for the cancellation of admission in such case.
- 6. The decision of the Principal of the college with regard to the admission shall remain final.

- 1. For Fee structure please refer to Table-I.
- 2. The student from University other than Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University or Board other than Maharashtra Board shall have to pay Rs. 200/- as immigration fee. He/she will have to produce Migration Certificate on or before 30th September 2024. The admission will be cancelled if the above requirement is not fulfilled within the said period.
- 3. The candidate leaving the college in the midst of the session cannot obtain Transfer Certificate unless he/she pays the fees for the complete session of the college.
- 4. The candidate who fails to obtain his deposit before the month of March will not get the same after the date. The amount will become apart of the Reserve Fund of the college.
- 5. The student will have to pay Rs. 100/- for the Duplicate Collge Transfer Certificate, documents, he/she will be required to pay Rs. 10/-.

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

The government gives financial aid to students. Following scholarships or free ship are available for the eligible students :-

1. E.B.C. (Economically Backward Classes) Concessions. 2. State Government Open Merit Free Studentship 3. State Open Merit Scholarship 4. National Scholarship Scheme 5. Concession to the children of Primary/Secondary/Jr.College Teachers 6.Government of India Scholarship to SC / ST / VJNT / SBC / OBC students 7. Scholarship and Educational Concession to children of Freedom Fighters 8. National Loan Scholarship. 9. Minority Students Scholarship for S.S.C. pass students. 10. Parent / Guardian has to pay full fees if Govt. not sanctioned scholarship/ Freeship

An eligible student can apply for only one kind of scholarship or freeship. Regarding the eligibility the student should contact the concerned authority in the office. Along with the application form for the scholarship, the form detailing the rules too has to be filled. The application form shall be submitted within three days after admission to the college.

INTRODUCTION

Shri Nagpur Gujarati Mandal, which was founded in 1905 proposed to start Arts and Commerce College in eastern part of the city in 1969-70. For this endeavor, the Mandal received a generous donation of Rs. 1 Lakh Twenty Five Thousand from the Vrajlal Manilal Vasant Charitable Trust, Gondia. In the same year the then Nagpur University, now Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University granted permission to the Mandal to start the Arts and Commerce College. To honour the invaluable services rendered by Late Shri Jaydeoshankar Thakar, its then Chairman, the Mandal named the Arts Faculty after him.

The Mandal in 1983-84, started Science Faculty in the memory of its former Secretary, Late Shri Jashbhai Patel. The Mandal also runs Primary KG to PG self financed undergraduate courses viz., B.Com. Computer Application, Bachelor of Business Administration, Bachelor of Computer Application and post graduate courses like Master of Computer Application, Master of Computer Management and Master of Commerce, PGDCCA, M. 



COLLEGE EXAMINATION

- 1. The college conducts Unit Tests. Non-appearance in the Unit Tests will be liable for fine of Rs. 20/- per paper/subject.
- 2. Internal Assessment of Students is being done by participation in Unit Test, Seminar, Quiz, Group Discussion, Powerpoint Presentation. Every Student has to appear for above activities for internal Assessment.
- 3. In case of absence in examination due to illness, the student has to inform the Principal during the examination itself. He/she can in such a situation, inform in writing about the submission of Medical Certificate within seven days of the last examination paper.
- 4. Every student of the college is required to pay Rs. 50/- towards college examination fee.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION:

As per the University rules, 75% attendance in each subject is compulsory. Otherwise the student will be disallowed to appear in the University examination. In such case, the college does not bear responsibility for the loss of one year of the student.

Admission to Semester: Eligibility for admission and taking university examination (ATKT Rules)

Ist Semester : Candidate should have passed the qualifying examination as per

the relevant direction governing the course.

IInd Semester : Candidate should have completed the 4 term of the 1st sem. and filled the examination form.

IIIrd Semester: Candidate should have completed the term of the IInd sem.

and filled the university examination form and has obtained exemption in :

a) 2/3 passing heads of the lst and IInd semester taken together, in the Post-graduate course. b) 50% passing heads of the lst and IInd semesters taken together in the under graduate course.

IVth semester: Candidate should have completed the term of the IIIrd semester and filled the exam form.

Vth Semester : Candidate should have

i) Completed the term of the IVth semester and filled the university examination form and ii) passed in the examinations of the 1st and IInd semesters and iii) Obtained exemption in a) 2/3 passing heads of the IIIrd and IV th semesters taken together, in the Post-graduate course b) 50% passing heads of the IIIrd and IVth semesters taken together in the under graduate course.

Vith Semester: Candidate should have completed the term of the Vth semesters and filled the examination form of Vth sem.

POST-GRADUATE COURSES -

Admission to Semester : Eligibility for admission and taking university examination

Ist Semester : Candidate should have passed the qualifying examination as per the relevant direction

governing the course.

IInd Semester : Candidate should have completed the term of the 1st sem and filled examination form.

IIIrd Semester : Candidate should have completed the term of the IInd sem and filled examination form of the

same and has obtained exemption in 2/3 passing heads of the 1st and 1Ind semesters taken

together.

IVth Semester : Candidate should have completed the term of the IIIrd semester and filled the examination

form of the same.

KNOWLEDGE RESOURCE CENTRE (LIBRARY):

The college has a digital library as well as a Reading Room. Books borrowed from library should be handled with care and returned within the specified time. Otherwise a fine will be charged as follows:

- 1. Re. 1 /- per day for General book and text book.
- 2. If the book is lost or torn, the same will have to be replaced. The current cost of the book may be accepted under special circumstances.

READING ROOM:

The college has a well-maintained Reading Room with English, Marathi, Hindi and Gujarati daily newspapers, weekly, fortnightly and monthly magazines. The magazines and journals are related to the subjects like Economics, Commerce, Science, Computer, Sports, Literature and General Knowledge. Entry into the Reading Room without the Identity Card is not permitted.

BOOK BANK FACILITY:

Book Bank facility is available to students. Those willing to avail the same will have to pay Rs 20/- as fee.

Note: Students can become members of the Nagpur University Library and Reading Room also.

GAMES AND SPORTS:

Students are trained under the supervision of qualified Physical Education Teachers for different games and Sports. Special coaching is given to students to participate in inter-collegiate sports competitions. Regular training in sports and games is necessary for all the students so that they get selected in the college teams.

PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST:

Physical efficiency test is compulsory for every student. The test is conducted by Nagpur University during January or February. The student who remains absent during this test can be disallowed to appear in the University Examination. The college will not be responsible for the consequences of the absence in the test.

NATIONAL CADET CORPS (N.C.C.):

Facility to join National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.) is available. Students not joining N.C.C. will have to attend P.T. Classes. 75% attendance of the students is compulsory in the P.T. classes.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (N.S.S):

The facility to join National Service Scheme (N.S.S.) is available for students.

PARKING FACILITY

Student who wants to keep their vehicles in the college will have to pay Rs. 150/- for parking facility. The college will not be responsible for the theft of the vehicles in the college. Locking of the parked vehicle is compulsory.

MEDICAL CHECK-UP:

Each student will be examined during the month of September by a doctor approved by the college. The medical report of the student will be sent to the University. Students who remain absent during the medical examination will either be fined Rs. 100/- or may not be permitted to appear in the University Examination.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

The purpose of the code of conduct and the rules of behavior is to ensure that all the students of the institute behave proper manner with due respect to teachers, fellow students and other college staff. The code of conduct holds the students responsible for the consequence of their action. (The manual includes standard procedure and practices to be followed by the student of the college pursuing various courses).

If a student or a group of students is seen by the faculty or other students violating the code of conduct, they may be subject to the disciplinary action by the college. The violation of following rules will invite penalty in the form of warning, fine, bidding parents to come to college, suspension or expulsion of the concerned student from the college.

Classroom rules

- 1. Students must attend the classes regularly and must ensure that they attend the lectures punctually.
- 2. Mobile phones are strictly not allowed in the classrooms. Mobile phones of all the students must be in switch off mode during the lecture hours.
- 3. Eating or Drinking is prohibited in the classrooms.
- 4. Students are expected not to take picture of notes, lecturer or other students in the classrooms.
- 5. No students shall enter or leave the class room during lecture session without the permission of the concerned faculty.
- 6. Students must have at least 75% of attendance in the college.
- 7. Students should come in the classrooms in decent formal attire.
- 8. Students are expected to sit in the library or reading rooms during free lectures . They should not loiter in the corridor.

General rules

- 1. Students are expected to maintain complete discipline in the College
- 2. Students are responsible for maintaining peace, harmony and order in the college.
- 3. Students are expected to preserve and safeguard the college property.
- 4. Students are expected to maintain cleanliness in the campus and also support in making the institute an ecologically "GREEN "campus.
- 5. Students are expected to attend all the activities organized by the college from time to time for their overall development.
- 6. Students should wear their IDENTITY CARDS during their stay in the college premises.
- 7. Students should not knowingly provide false or misleading information or to the college office.
- 8. All kinds of tattooing, piercing, hair styling that goes against the existing social norms of acceptable and proper behavior will be referred to the discipline committee.
- 9. Consumption of intoxicants/psychotropic substance in any form or smoking or using chewing gum, Pan Masala is strictly prohibited.
- 9. Students should strictly refrain from scribbling, writing on walls, doors and furniture.

- 10. Students are not permitted to arrange any unauthorized celebration in the college campus.
- 11. Display of banners, posters within the college premises and its precincts without the permission of authority is prohibited.
- 12. Behavior such as sexual harassment that threatens learning, and work environment will not be tolerated
- 13. No student may possess or use a weapon, explosive or destructive devices.
- 14. Involvement in any criminal activity under Indian penal code will result in expulsion or suspension of the student.
- 15. Theft and negligent or intentional damage to personal or college property is prohibited.

 Disciplinary action will be taken against the accused student, and repair and replacement costs will be charged.
- 16. Students should not engage in plagiarism, cheating on exams or other dishonesty.
- 17. Any student who disrupts any college function intentionally shall be subject to disciplinary action.
- 18. Harassing juniors, ill treatment to the fellow students or any such form of RAGGING is objectionable and liable to be treated as criminal offence.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) The student should provide exact information about the gap-period during his/her education, the reason for the gap, total gap-period, any government scholarship if availed of during the gap period.
- 2) The forms for the scholarship and free ship will be available in college office.
- 3) The student will get complete information regarding the rules for free ship from the college office and college website.
- 4) Student should read the instruction displayed on the notice board daily to update their information regarding scholarship and free ship. They can also seek the information from college website.
- 5) It is the prime responsibility of students to submit the duly filled in form within the prescribed time limit. The college shall bear no responsibility if the form is rejected. In such case the student will be responsible to pay the full fees.
 - He/she will not be issued the admission card for appearing in the annual examination unless full fee is deposited.
- 6) Caste Certificate and Income Certificate certified by the Class-I Magistrate or Tahsildar will only be accepted as per Government rule.
- 7) The student will have to pay the charges or fees not exempted by the Government on any ground of concession.
- 8) The student shall have to pay the cycle stand charges when they come for the University / Board / any other agency's examination.
- 9) The students must insure their vehicles, college will not be responsible for the theft of the vehicles
- 10) The vehicles shall be properly locked at the vehicle stand.
