For this academic year 2023-24, feedback has been collected from 1648 students across the streams of Arts, Commerce and Management, Science, and Computer Departments.

The feedback committee submits its analysis to the IQAC Coordinator. The coordinator then calls the meeting of all HOD's and Coordinators under chairmanship of the principal. On the basis of the observations and suggestions in the meeting, the Action Taken Report is prepared. This report is placed before the College Development Committee for its perusal.

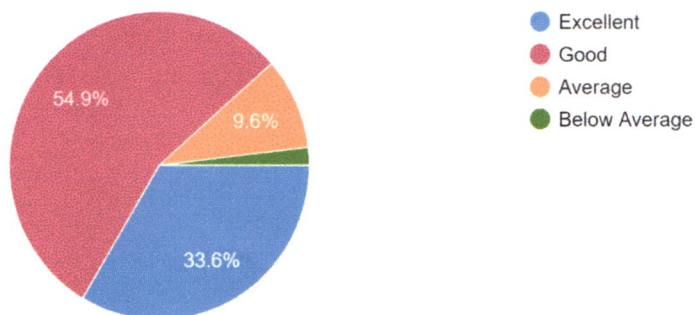

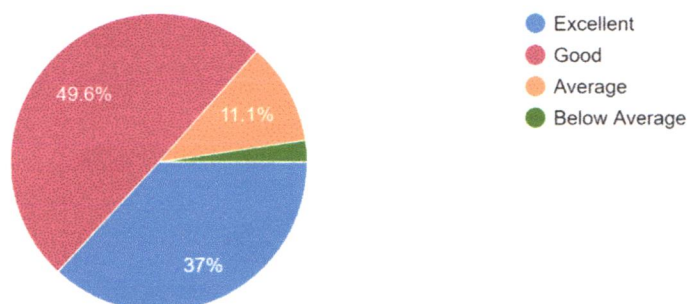

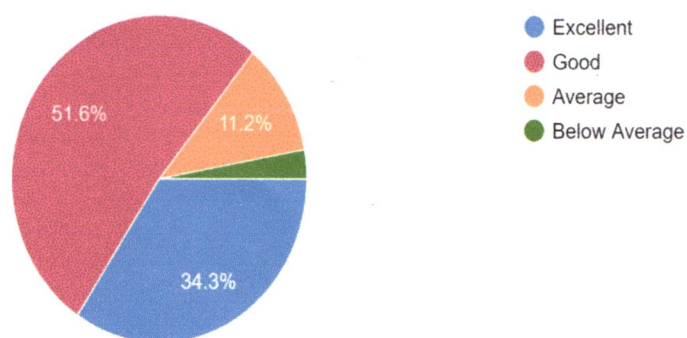

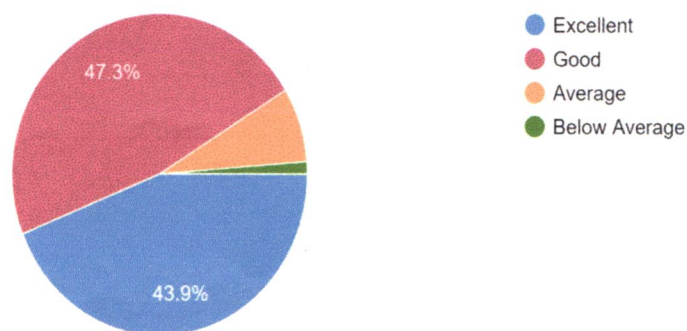

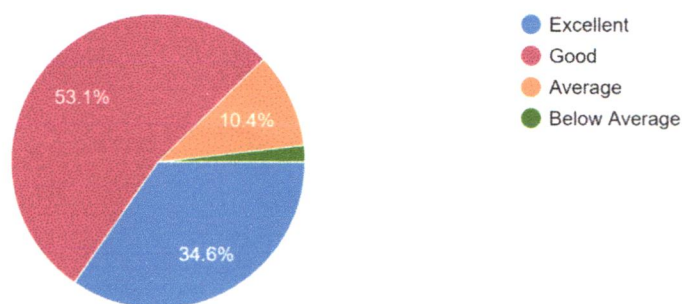

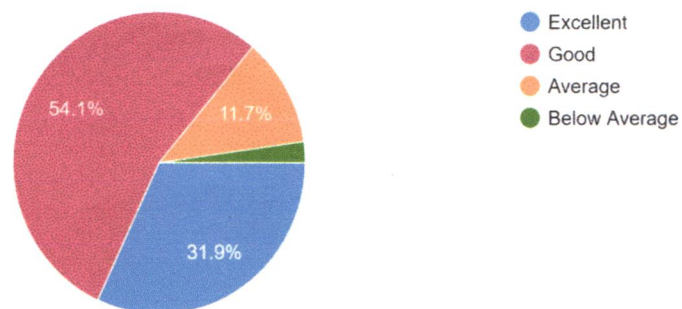

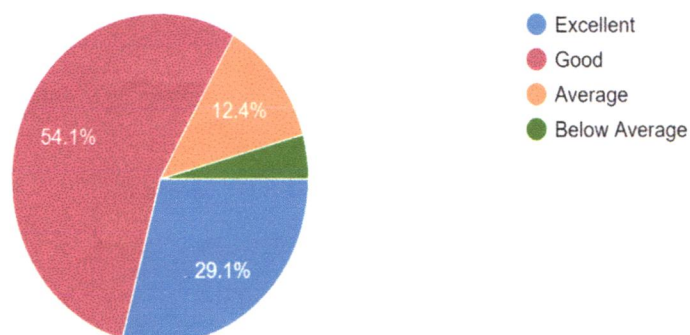

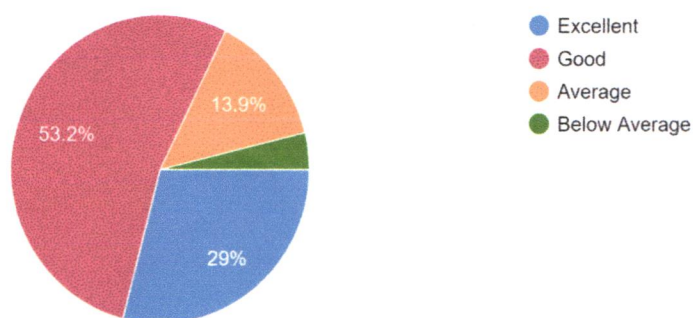

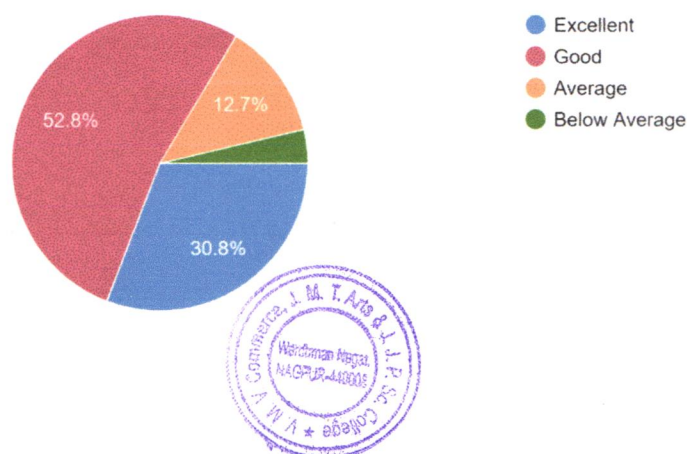

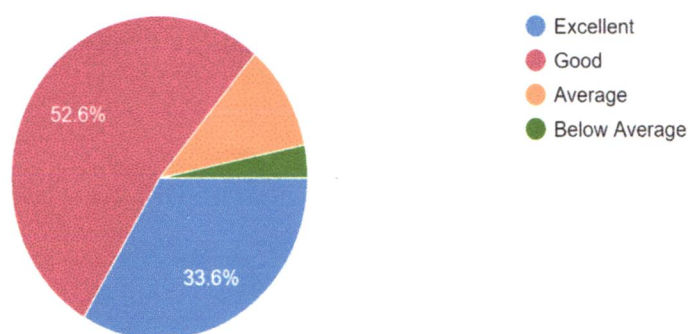

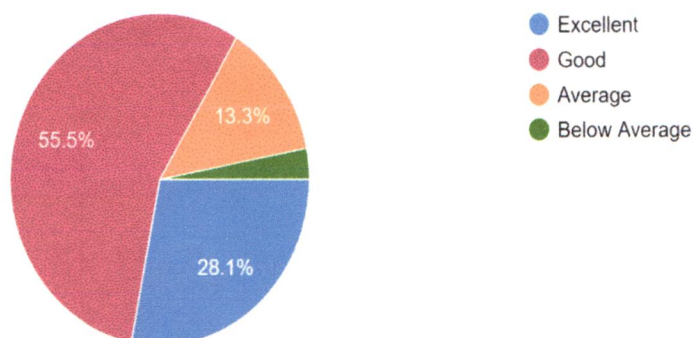

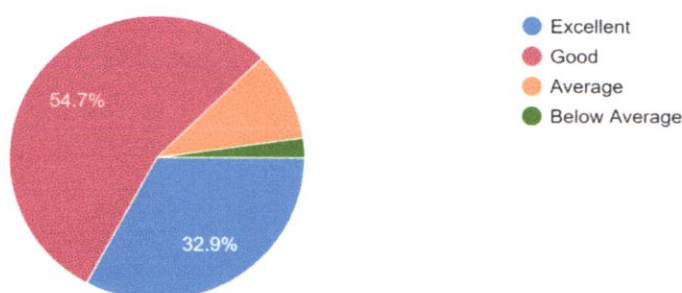

ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK ON ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE AND AMBIENCE BY TEACHERS :

The institution's feedback committee designs the feedback and collects feedback from its stakeholders to monitor and evaluate its performance quality on academic performance and ambience. The feedback was invited from teachers on issues like academic performance and ambience with respect to the suitability of the course and its need, outcome of the curriculum, relationship with course content and corresponding reference material, availability of reference materials vis-à-vis curriculum, evaluation methods and curriculum delivery, FDP training and financial assistance in research etc..

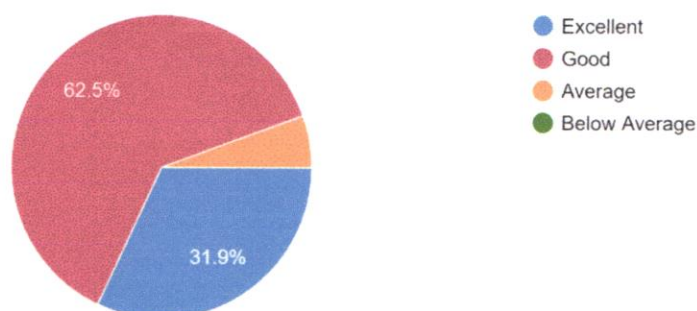

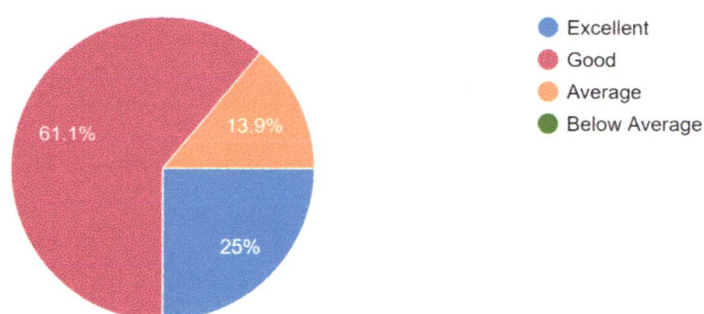

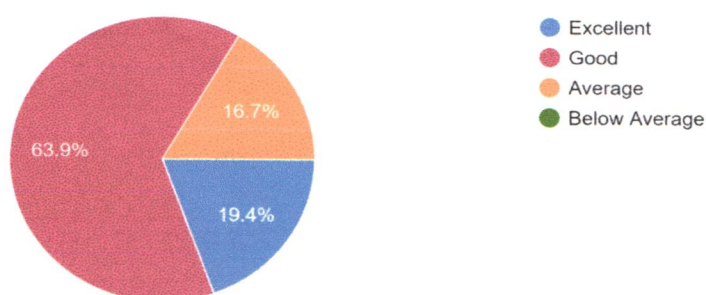

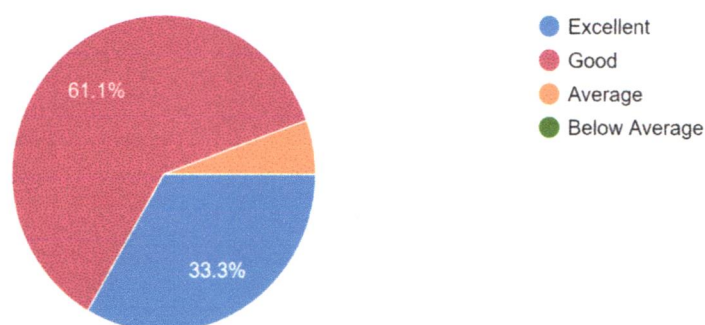

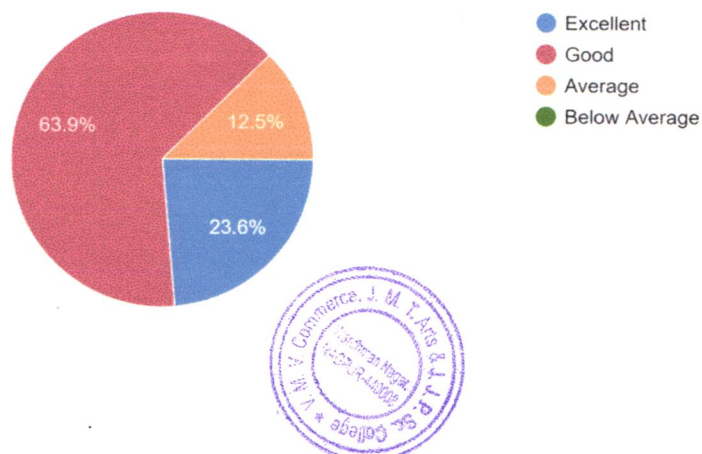

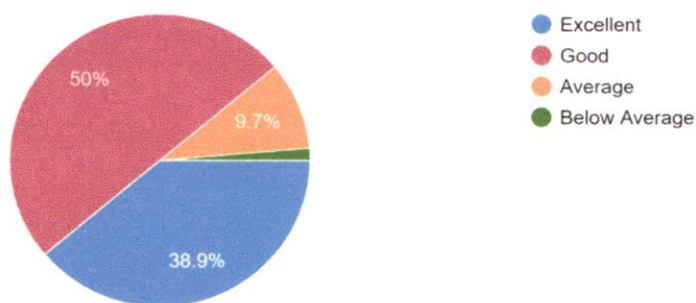

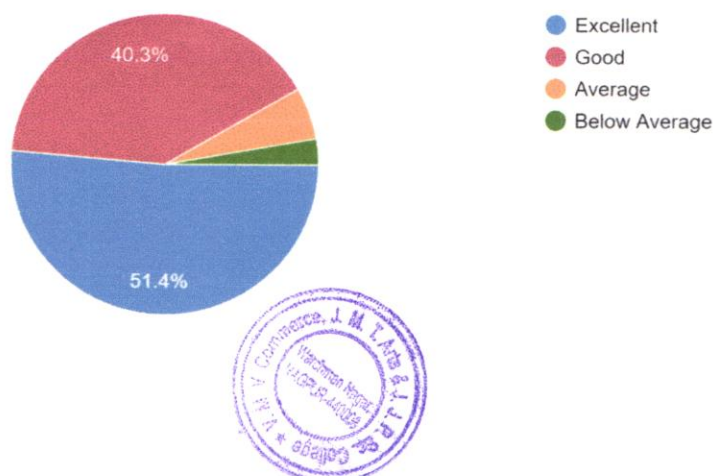

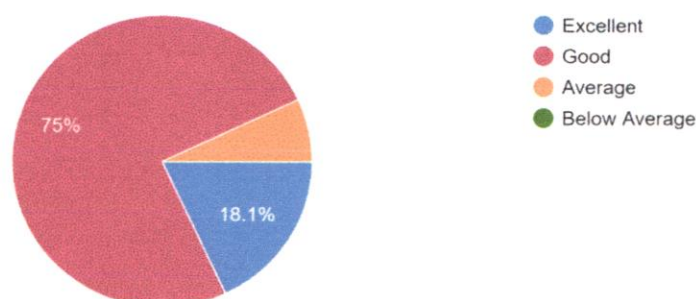

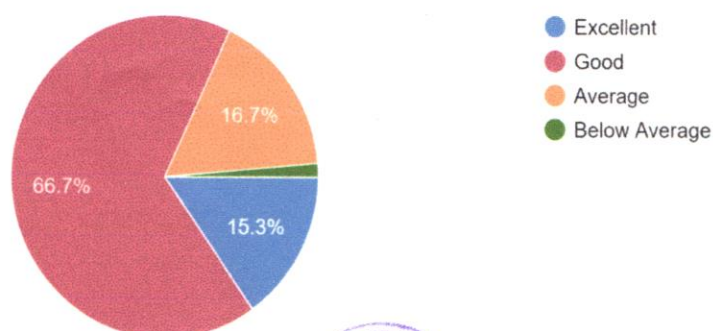

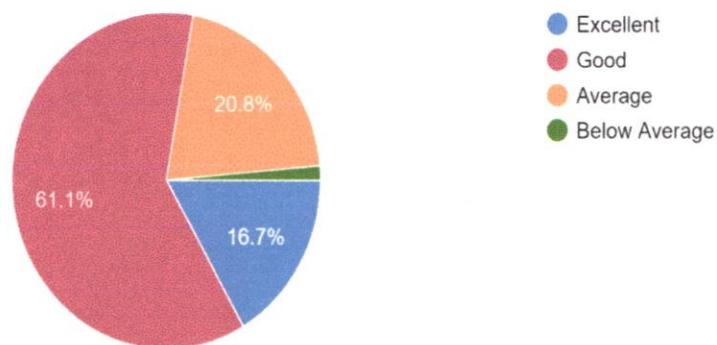

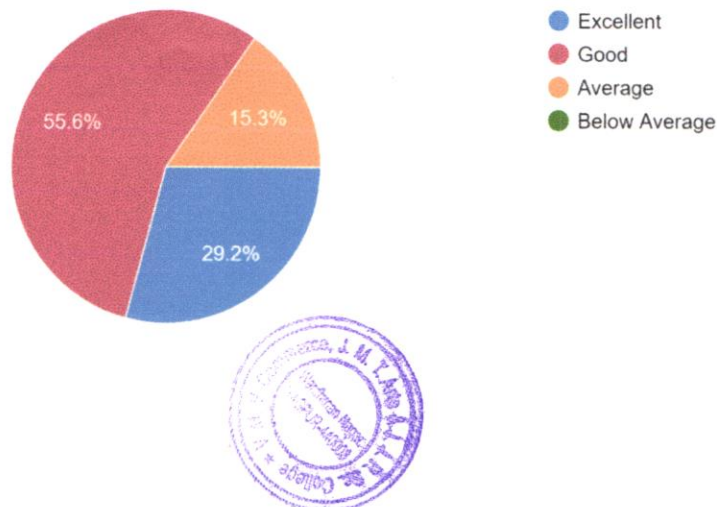

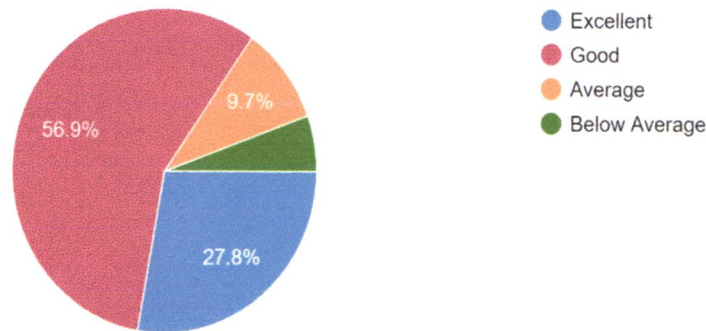


13. Infrastructure addresses the needs of differently-abled stake holders.

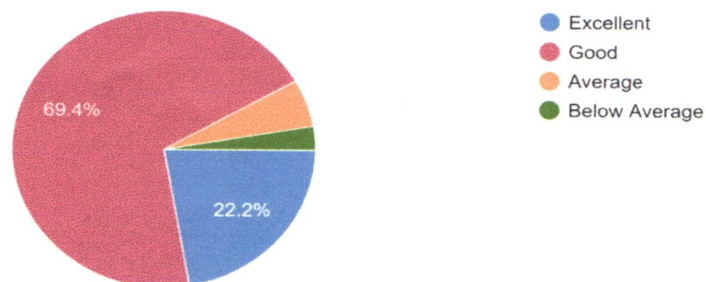

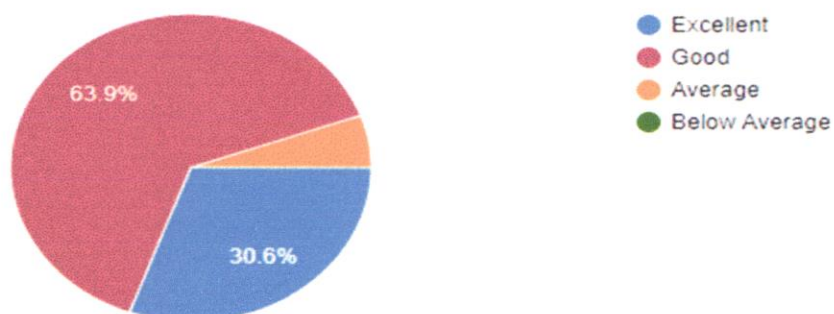

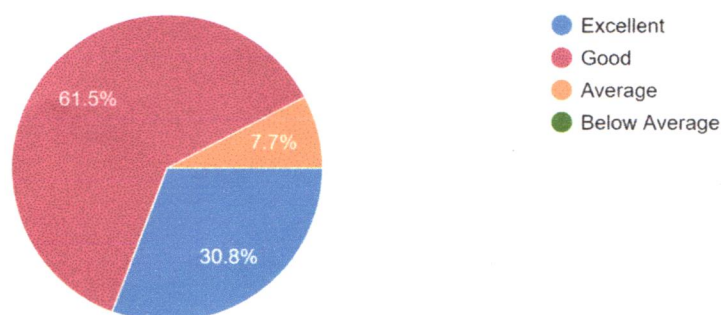

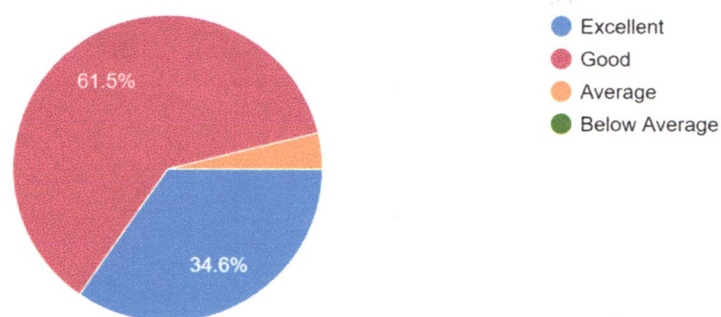

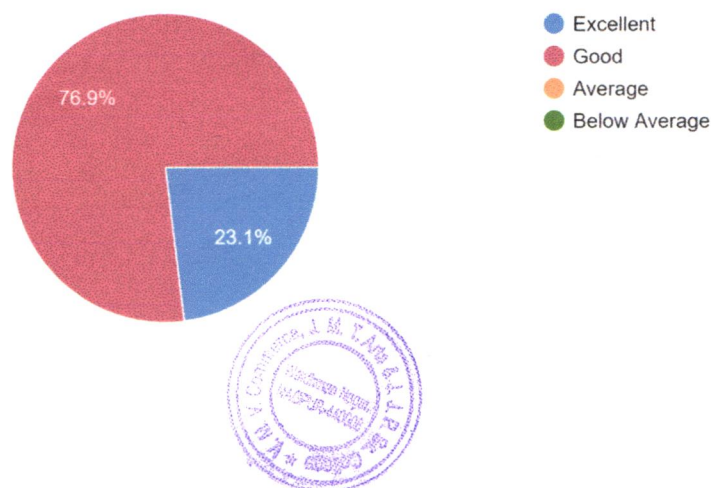


6) Our Graduates employees have self –learning and lifelong learning capabilities

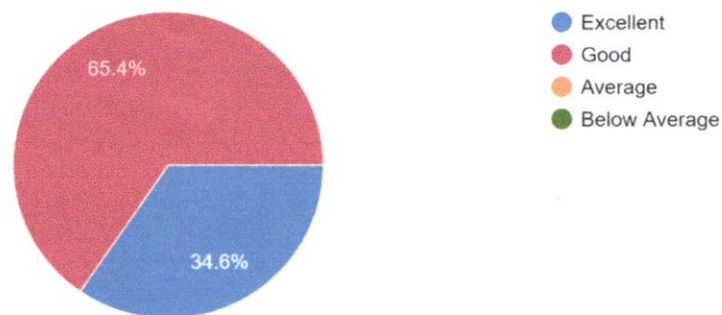

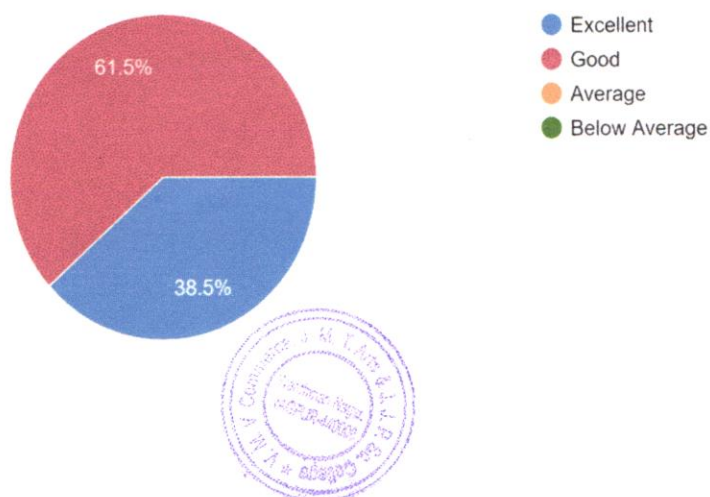

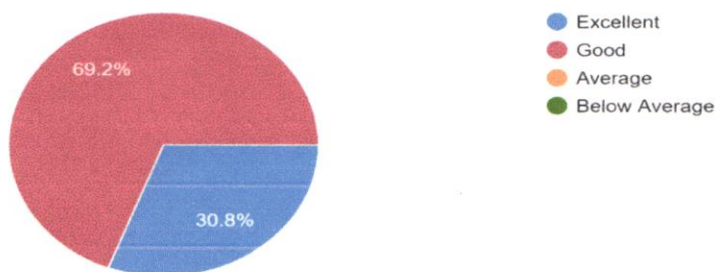

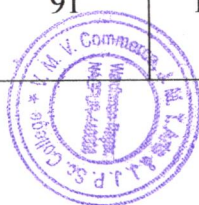
ANALYSIS OF FEEDBACK ON ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE AND AMBIENCE BY ALUMNI:

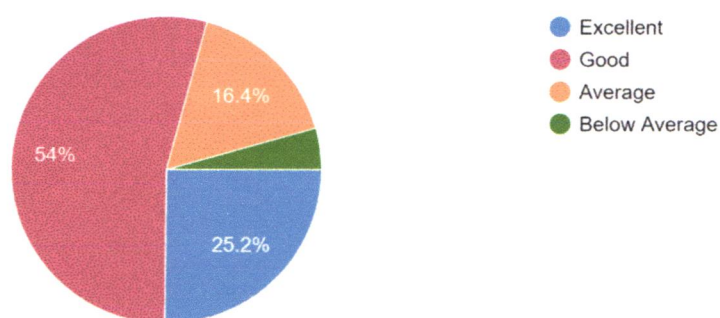

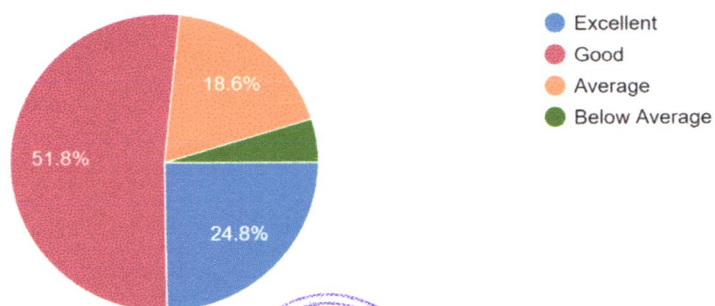

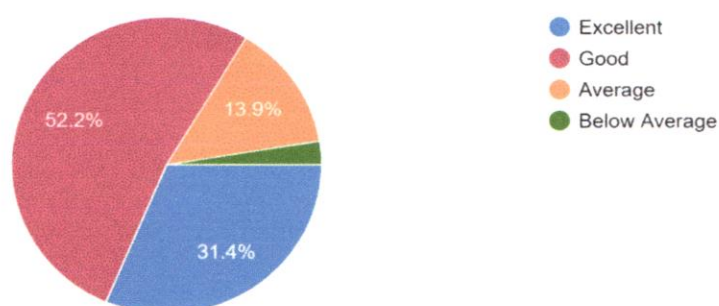

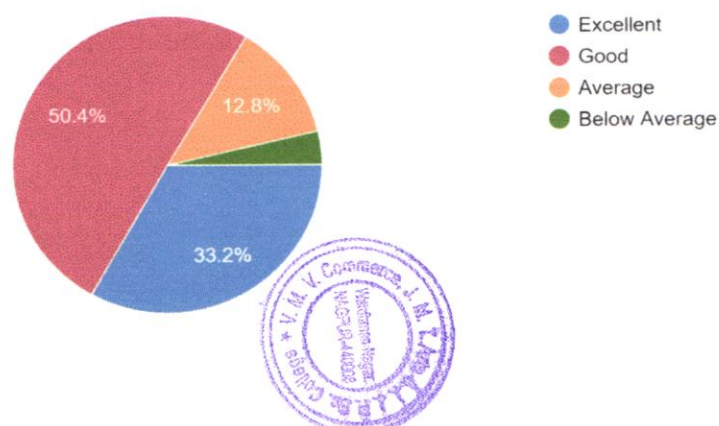

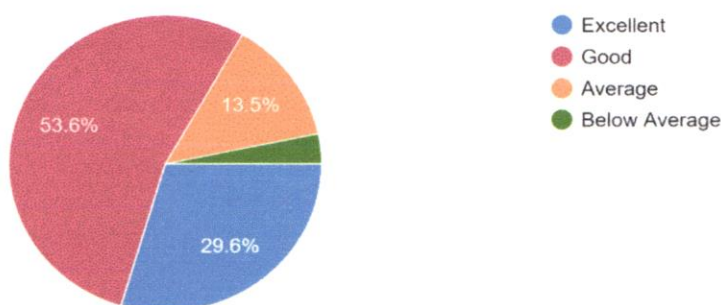

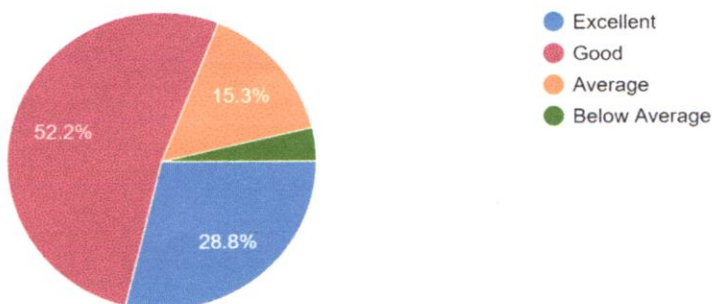

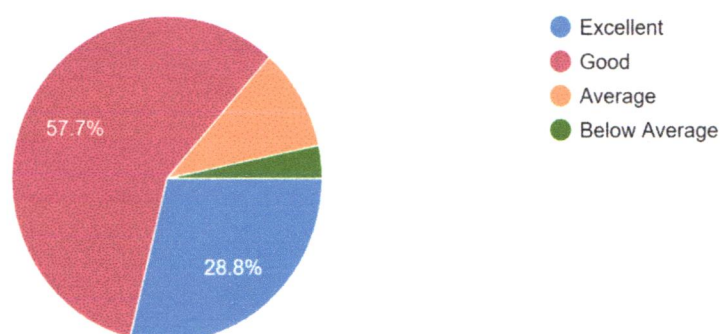

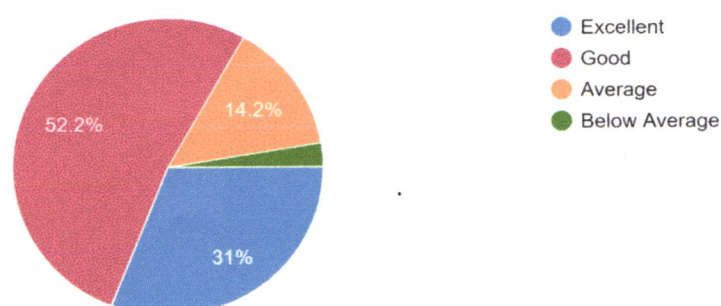

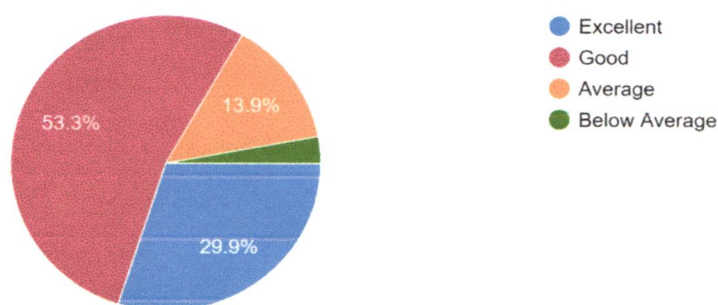
