Gujarati linguistic minority student policy

Preamble

Being one of the oldest institutes dedicated towards the promotion and spread of education in this part of India, Shri Nagpur Gujarati Mandal has been rendering unflinching services for this cause. Since its inception in 1905 by a handful of enthusiastic philanthropist Gujaratis, namely, Shri. Rajaram Dixit, Shri. Soubhagyachand Kothari, Shri. Shri Nagpur Gujarati Mandal is the only century-old institution beyond the boundaries of the then Greater Gujarat State.

The visionary forefathers of the Mandal started 'Itwari Gujarati Shikshan Sanstha' with a meagre number of 28 students, who proved to be the sheet-anchor of the Mandal and subsequently established many educational institutions. The Mandal has seen many ups and downs in its life, but because of the total and single-minded dedication of the members, it has completed 100 years of its eventful and purposeful journey. 

- **Fee concession** - VMV college endeavours to provide financial assistance to meritorious students belonging to the Gujarati linguistic minority with poor financial background in the form of concession in admission fees
- **Awards for meritorious students belonging to minority community**—The institution, in association with Nagpur Gujarati Samaj, felicitates meritorious students belonging to the Gujarati linguistic minority community with cash rewards and trophies.
