This competition stands as a tribute to his commitment to academic inquiry, intellectual growth, and scholarly excellence.

Eligibility

- The competition is open to undergraduate and postgraduate teachers of Colleges & Universities.
- Papers should be duly submitted through the Head of the Institution
- Each participant may submit only one research paper.

Themes

Participants are invited to submit research papers under any one of following three major themes :

- Knowledge, Power and the Making of Truth: An Interdisciplinary Inquiry
- Emotional Intelligence: A Foundation of Holistic well-being
- Ethical Concerns and Challenges in Public Life

Submission Guidelines

- The research paper must be original, unpublished, and free from plagiarism.
- The paper shall be written in English, Hindi, Marathi & Gujarati using a clear academic style.
- The length of the paper should be between 2,500 and 4,000 words, excluding references and annexes. The paper must follow standard formatting :
English-Font: Times New Roman Size 12, Line Spacing: 1.5, Margin: 1 inch on all sides
Hindi, Marathi & Gujarati: Unicode language.
- A soft copy must be submitted to the designated email address, and a hard copy must be submitted to the committee office within the prescribed deadline.

Authorship and Declaration

- Papers may be authored individually or jointly by a maximum of two participants.
- All submitted research papers must be original and free from plagiarism. Any form of plagiarism will lead to immediate disqualification of the paper.
- The use of AI-generated content, data, analysis, or references is strictly prohibited. Authors are solely responsible for the authenticity, originality, and academic integrity of their work.
- Papers found to violate these ethical standards at any stage of review shall be rejected without further consideration.

Evaluation Criteria

- Research originality and relevance
- Clarity of objectives and methodology
- Depth of analysis and interpretation, Quality of writing and organisation
- Proper citation and referencing (APA/MLA/Chicago style as specified by the committee)

Evaluation

- Papers will be evaluated by a panel of subject experts/examiners appointed by the Chairman, Late Advocate Chandrakantbhai Thakar Memorial Research Paper Competition Committee.
- The examiners' decision shall be final and binding.

Awards and Recognition

- Prizes will be awarded to the top two papers.
 - 1st Prize-Cash Award of Rs. 21000/- & Certificate
 - 2nd Prize-Cash Award of Rs. 11000/- & Certificate
- Certificate of Merit will be issued to prize winners, and Certificates of Participation will be given to all eligible participants.
- Selected papers may be published in the institutional publications at the discretion of the committee.

Disqualification

- Submissions found to contain plagiarised content or violate any rule will be disqualified
- Late submissions will not be accepted under any circumstances.

General Conditions

- The organising committee reserves the right to modify rules, timelines, or evaluation procedures if necessary.
- All participants shall abide by the rules and decisions of the committee.
